**GENERAL NATURE OF WORK**

Parent Educators (PEs) provide home visiting and other family support services to families with children 0-5 years of age utilizing the Parents as Teachers program and curriculum with fidelity. The PE:

- Provides education and support in the areas of parent-centered development, parent-child interaction, and family well-being
- Completes family and child assessments
- Provides appropriate support, including referrals and linkages to community resources, for identified needs
- Works with other PEs to coordinate Group Connection/Parent Support meetings, which engage parents in activities that increase their knowledge and skills and provide networking opportunities to learn with and from other parents, sharing their own experiences in the process
- Engages in outreach and recruitment activities as needed to support the program.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- Bachelor or four-year degree in early childhood education, social work, health, psychology, or a related field is recommended (or equivalent degree in countries outside of the United States) OR have a two-year degree or 60 college hours in early childhood or related field and supervised experience working with young children and parents OR a high school diploma and a minimum of two years previous supervised work experience with parents of young children
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills (e.g., nonjudgmental, objective, reflective, empathetic, patient, tactful)
- Ability to establish rapport with families and empower them by building on their strengths
- Strong organizational, planning, and record-keeping/data management skills
- Ability to work independently and be self-motivated (often in the field)
- Strong computer skills, including word-processing and data entry
- Access to reliable transportation for routine travel throughout the county for home visits and meetings.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS**

Experience in case management, linking families to community resources, and providing health education and well-informed of community resources. Being fluent in Spanish is recommended but not required.
